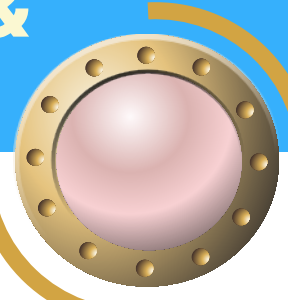


Swindon Model Boat & Engineering Club

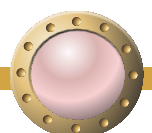
Coate Trophy

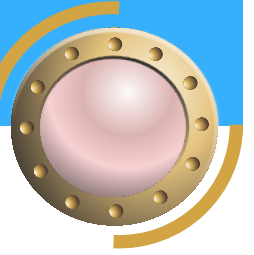


Awarded for Steam driven craft.
